

Goldfields Library Corporation Internet Use Policy

Internet access is available at all Goldfields Library Corporation Libraries. Access is free with a time limit of 60 minutes per user per day. Users must have a current GLC Library Card. Visitors to the Region may request single use access.

Bookings may be required for the use of the Library's Internet computers. While library staff are happy to assist users in accessing the Internet, each user is nonetheless responsible for their own search.

All computer users of electronic information resources such as the Internet and Library Catalogue are expected to use these resources in a responsible manner, consistent with the educational and informational purposes for which they are provided.

The Library reserves the right to implement software and hardware control mechanisms to block information the Library has determined inconsistent with its mission. The Library assumes no responsibility for any damages, direct or indirect, arising from use of its database server or from its connection to other Internet Services.

Each individual user must take responsibility for their own activities on the Internet. Parents are required to be responsible for their under 18 year old children's Internet sessions. While most of the information accessed using the Library's computer system and Internet resources can be valuable and enlightening, the user may also find materials that are unreliable, personally offensive or illegal under Australian law.

Sending, receiving or displaying text or graphics which may reasonably be construed as obscene by community standards is unacceptable. The Library reserves the right to terminate the Internet access privileges of any person who violates the accepted standards.
