How do I search?

- Search by any or several keywords you may know (for example the name, year, ship etc.)
- Some names may be abbreviated (for example ' J' Smith or simply 'Mr' Smith)
- For a more exact name search use 'AND' between first and last name.
- Consider using the filter option (for example 1854) to further refine your search and/or the sort functionality by clicking on the headings of each column.

Type the name in the first box. Your results will look like this:

<u>Assisted passenger list:</u> The original records are closed to public <u>access</u> due to their fragility, most of the data has been copied onto the index above. The <u>Register of Assisted Immigrants from U.K. (Books 1-14A)</u> 1839-1871 can be viewed <u>Ancestry.com.au</u>

<u>Coastal passenger lists:</u> Enter the information you have into the search fields on <u>Find My Past.com.au</u> to see transcripts and images of the original coastal passenger lists held by Public Record Office Victoria

<u>Outwards passenger lists</u>: To view the original records, note the year and month you've discovered in the search above, browse the listing within the Record Series Number <u>VPRS 948/P1 Outward Passengers</u> to Interstate, U.K. and Foreign Ports. Once you have found records of interest to you, order them online from the PROV and then view in the PROV Reading Room.

You must be a member of the PROV to order records online. You can join from the homepage using the "I want to...." box which is on the bottom right hand side of the homepage.
