Welcome to Goldfields Libraries! We have produced this booklet to help you make the most of your free library membership, and to let you know about all the wonderful resources and opportunities available from your local library.

Goldfields libraries have a regularly updated collection of fiction, non-fiction and large print books for adults, picture books for children, junior fiction and young adult fiction. There are also DVDs, audiobooks and the latest magazines.

Library users can search the library catalogue online and reserve any of the 300,000 items across the entire Goldfields Libraries collection. Items can then be collected from your branch or agency of choice.


Remember, with your library card you can borrow from any branch or agency and return items to any branch or agency!



Browsing the catalogue and reserving items

You can browse the entire Goldfields Library catalogue online, reserve items, and collect them at your local agency or branch!





You will be notified by SMS or email once the item arrives, and it will then be held for 10 days.

You can check the status of your reservation(s) by logging into your account (see next page on how to log in) and clicking on 'Pending reservations' on your dashboard.

Renewing borrowed items online

It is possible to renew the loan period of a borrowed item online, <u>as long</u> as it has not been reserved by another patron.

At the top right of the screen, click on 'Login'.


In the drop-down box, enter your library card number (long number underneath barcode on your library card), and your password.

Click on 'Login'.

On your dashboard, click on 'Current loans'.

Tick the checkbox(es) next to item(s) you want to renew.

Library App

The library has an easy to use mobile app that allows you to browse the catalogue and reserve items, as well as renew items you already have on loan. It is available for Apple and Android.

Download the free 'Spydus Mobile' app from Google Play (Android) or the App Store (Apple).

Once installed, open the app and select 'Goldfields Libraries' as your library.


Click on 'Login'.

Enter your library card number (long number underneath barcode on your library card), and your password. Click on 'Please select a branch...' and select your local library or agency.

Ensure 'Remember me' is turned on, and click 'Login'.

Once logged in, you can:

- Click on 'My Account' to see items currently on loan and renew items.
- Click on 'Scan' to scan the barcode of any book, magazine or DVD when out and about to check if it is available at the library, and if it is, reserve it straight away!
- Click on 'Discover' to search our catalogue and reserve items.




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eLibrary

The library has a fantastic range of resources available through our eLibrary, which can be accessed for FREE, 24/7 through our website! To start, go to www.ncgrl.vic.gov.au/elibrary. Note that some resources require you to be on a library computer or connected to our Wi-Fi, and some may require you to log in with your library card number and password. Here are just **some** of the fantastic resources available in our eLibrary:

eBooks, audiobooks and magazines are available for free on Borrowbox (eBooks, audiobooks), rbDigital (eBooks, audiobooks, magazines), uLibrary (audiobooks) and PressReader (magazines and newspapers from around the world in many languages). Apps are available for Apple and Android devices for all these platforms.
